Extension of Early Years Provision in Halwill - Update

Following positive discussions between Scallywags and Halwill Primary, we are moving forward with plans to expand the early years provision in the village. The most viable plan is the amalgamation of both, to form a school-based nursery starting from 9 months. This will be a big project for both parties, but our aim is to increase provision to better support the families in our area.

We are still working out what this would look like, however any project like this is completely reliant on funding. There is currently government funding available for such projects, and we are now in the process of applying for that, as well as seeking Local Authority support. Without both, we cannot move forward with any plans and this, of course, will all take time.

Once we know funding is secured, we will of course share updates as to exactly what a school-based nursery provision would look like and what it would mean for both Scallywags and the School.
